In cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he offered his services for this purpose and to whom and why they were declined.

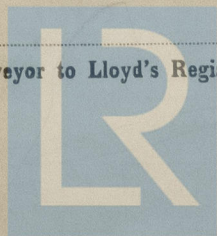
