

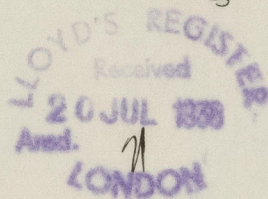

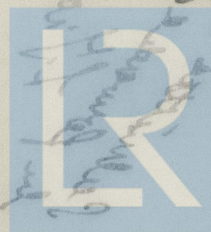
Referring to your letter of the 13th instant regarding our report No.274 on engine No. 480754/59 made by Messrs. Humboldt-Deutzmotoren A.G. and intended for Messrs. W.S. Bailey & Co., Yard No.292 we beg to state the following. An independent spare lubricating oil pump ready for immediate use will not be delivered by Messrs.Humboldt-Deutz, but only a spare one which is to be fitted in case of a breakdown of the main engine driven lubricating oil pump. Such a spare lubricating oil pump is always supplied for every engine for main propelling purposes. Regarding the additional means circulating the cooling water we have been informed by Messrs. Humboldt-Deutz that these are provided by the Yard.
