Messrs. Osaka Shosen Kaisha, attend on board the Steel Twin Screw Steamer "A R A B I A M A R U", of Osaka, on the 5th March, and 15th, 21st and 25th April, 1924, as she lay in Nagasaki Harbour to test, examine and report on the Port and Starboard Deep Tank, also the Fore Peak Tank being conditioned for the purpose of carrying a shipment of wood oil in bulk.

The above mentioned tanks were tested under a head of water, (also double bottom tank below deep tank) and found sound.

The deep tanks were finally examined on the 21st April, and the Fore Peak Tank on the 25th April. All were found to be clean free from rust paint scale residue and moisture and in fit condition to receive a shipment of wood oil in bulk, subject to same being again examined at loading port.
