

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed 100A-1 (Steel) Shelter Deck with freeboard," as recommended. The Summer freeboard of 13.15 from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at Shelter deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying verification form to be inserted in the certificate of classification.

It is concluded cargo buttes are fitted in the shelter Dks but the Surveyor should state if this is so. He should also be requested to sign the copies of approved plans & mark thereon the date of approval in future cases where the approved plans are returned for his guidance in the building of sister vessels.
