H. With reference to previous correspondence relative to the tug "FOAM", I have to acquaint you that on the 31st ultimo the Committee gave instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

For your information I enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated the 11th instant received from the Owners and shall be glad if you will give the case attention and let me know in due course what is done in the matter.

At the same time I have to inform you that the Owners have today telephoned to this Office stating that if the work done at Alexandria is sufficient for Reclassification purposes they will consider the question of having the vessel reclassified, but should the requirements be too extensive and the expenses for the work very heavy the question of Reclassing will be dropped.
