Reverting to your letter of the 4th February last, respecting the tug "FOAM", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case under their consideration to-day together with a cablegram received from the Society's Surveyor at Alexandria, from which it appears that the vessel has not yet come under inspection for the Second Special Survey No. 2 as arranged.
