Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under further consideration to-day the case of your tug "FOAM", together with your letter of the 27th ultimo, and in reply I have the pleasure to say that in the special circumstances you mention, the class of this vessel will be allowed to remain undisturbed in the Register Book on the faith of your promise that she will be sent to Alexandria not later than June next with a view to carrying out the Special Survey No.2 and permanent repairs.

It must, however, be clearly understood that in the event of the vessel being offered for sale, intending purchasers are to be informed to the effect that for the retention of her class, permanent repairs of the grounding damage require to be effected and the Special Survey No.2 carried out on hull and machinery at a date not later than June next.
