Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant enclosing application froms for amended freeboards to be assigned to various vessels belonging to you, and have to acquaint you that the same is receiving attention.

In the cases of the Steamers "ASHRIDGE", "COOEYANNA" and "KOORINGA" it will be possible to assign amended freeboards without any surveys being held, and I shall have pleasure in sending you the necessary particulars in a day or two.

In the cases of the steamers "KALGOORLIE", "NEW GUINEA" and "COOLGARDIE" further particulars will be required, and in that of the Steamer "WORRONGA" full measurements are necessary, as this vessel has not previously had a freeboard assigned by this Society, and I am sending the necessary instructions to the Society's Surveyors at Melbourne by this mail.
