W.C.s etc removed from tonnage well and shell openings closed with spigot patches

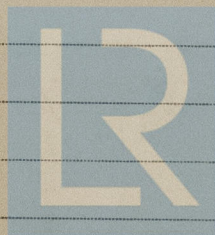
Gun seating for^d forming companion access to for^d peak stores, removed.

Access to stores thro companion. Companion of steel, with hinged steel door, operated both sides. Sill 24" above deck.
