Experimental

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The class of this vessel is subject to repairs being effected to the stem at the first convenient opportunity.

The Annual Survey became due in 1920 and the Special Survey No.1 in December, 1923.

The barge has been laid up and the usual undertaking furnished by the Owners.

The Newcastle Surveyors report that the vessel has been examined in dry dock and some repairs have been effected at the stem, but the Annual Survey has not been held, it being understood the vessel was to be sold and towed to Spain.

In reply to enquiry the late Owners, Messrs. Stelp & Leighton, stated on the 13th instant that the transfer would no doubt be completed on that day.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Tuesday, 14th instant when, in all the circumstances, instructions were given for the class to be expunged from the Register Book with Red Line (617), indicating non-compliance with the Society's rules, and the new Owner has been so informed.
