I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant relative to the steamer "GRANDLIEU", the contents of which have been noted, and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will forward full particulars of webs, covers, coamings, battening arrangements etc. Of No.3 hatchway in the bridge space, at the same time stating the thickness of the wood covers and the bearing surface of the bunker hatchways on the bridge deck.

I shall also be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know when and at what port it will best suit their convenience to have the bunker hatchways on the freeboard deck in the bridge space submitted to examination with a view to the completion of the freeboard report.
