I am in receipt of your letter of the 22nd. July 1919 in relation to the freeboard verification of the S. S. "WAR DRUMMER" at this port, and in reply thereto would state that the storm windows mentioned in my report, are fitted in riveted channels, and at the full height of the openings in the bulkhead at the after end of the bridge.

With reference to the alteration of the freeboard markings mentioned in your letter, I would state that the vessel left this port on June 5th. 1919, bound for Java to load for England, and, as she is not likely to return to these waters, I would recommend that the information be forwarded to Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co. Liverpool, who are managing this vessel for the Ministry of Shipping.
