With reference to your memo of the 8th instant in connection with the Load Line <sup>Survey</sup> on the M.V. "REGENT TIGER", I have to confirm that the hatches on the poop and forecastle decks, together with their covers and means of securing <sup>same</sup> were examined and found in good order in all respects.

Reference your letter of the 22nd instant instant in connection with the S.S. "IERE" the owner has informed me that he desires a Load Line Certificate to be issued by this Society and I shall be glad if you will forward any instructions regarding same at earliest possible date as the Owner is very keen to put his vessel into service.

Reference your letter of the 21st instant in connection with the above vessel I note that the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged with a red line in the Register Book, and I have informed the owners accordingly.

Reference your letter of the 20th instant in connection with the gauge glass mountings of the S.S. "MAKENA 11" I have to report that the fitting of the gauge glass mountings on the above vessel's Boilers comply with the rules except for the shut off valves which have been fitted temporarily in place of the regulation cocks.

There are no gauge glass cocks available in this area and the above valves were fitted temporarily to allow the vessel to remain in service, pending receipt of regulation cocks.
