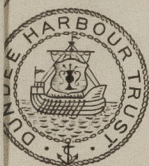

In reply to your letter of the 31st. Decr., 1941, addressed to Secretary, Dundee Harbour Trustees, I have to state that it has been usual practice of my Trustees to have the Tay Ferries vessels built to Lloyd's Classification and then automatically drop it as the ships come under the Board of Trade (Ministry of War Transport) classification for Passenger Certificates and I presume it will be their wish to do the same with the above vessel.

Owing to an extension of this ship's Passenger Certificate having been granted, last year, she is now undergoing her Annual Survey, under the supervision of the Ministry of War Transport's Surveyor for this year, and it is hoped to have every thing completed and on service about the 15th. inst.

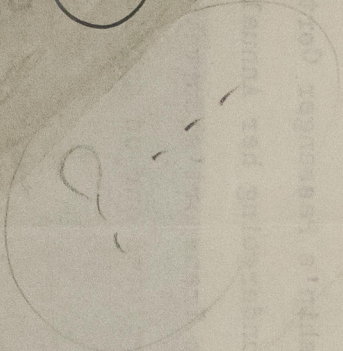
