Dear Sir,

I return herewith the First Entry Certificates on the Hull and Machinery of the Motor Ferry "ABERCRAIG" as the description thereon, namely: "one propeller forward and aft" is not correct.

I should explain that, although the vessel was originally designed with one Voith-Schneider propeller forward and one aft, it was subsequently decided to fit both propellers aft. The vessel is described on the First Entry Report as "Twin Screw", which would have met the case, but on further discussion in this Office it is thought that perhaps a better description would be "Steel Motor Ferry (Twin Prop.)."

I shall be glad if you will kindly let me have amended certificates as soon as possible as the Builders are pressing for these documents.
