Sir,

We duly received your letter of the 26th ultimo respecting the steamer "SORKA" and beg to inform you that the vessel was laid up at Tønsberg while waiting for the new engine and boilers.

We have not examined the vessel in dry dock during that time but the builders now state that the vessel was placed on slipway on the 10th September 1917, 9th of August 1918, 20th of June 1919 and 26th of August 1919 and each time she was cleaned and painted. Last time she was placed on slipway was for fitting the propeller.

The builders' letter is enclosed.
