S. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant respecting the whaler "GUN 7", and with reference to the letter you have received from the Owners' Representative at Tonsberg requesting that arrangements be made "for the vessel's class to be continued in the meantime", I would point out, as stated in my letter to you of the 16th December last, the vessel's class has already been expunged with a red line. Before therefore, her class can be re-instated, it will be necessary for the 2nd Special Survey No.1 and all necessary repairs to be carried out.
