M.V. "DEMOCRAAT".

I return herewith the plans, received with your letter of the 14th instant, of midship section, profile & decks and sternframe & rudder for the above ship and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the requirements of the Rules for Vessels not built under Survey be complied with, including the carrying out of a No. 3 survey, the scantlings be verified and reported on the usual First Entry Report and you satisfy yourself that the structural arrangements in the bottom forward and in the panting area are efficient, then, on receipt of a satisfactory report on completion of the Survey, the vessel could be recommended to the Committee for the Class 100A-"Coasting Service", the limits of which should be supplied for consideration.

If the figure "I" is desired, then, in addition to the equipment indicated on the plans the following should be supplied:

135 Metres steel wire 57 mm. circ.
65 " hemp hawser 102 mm. "

I shall be pleased to receive the necessary copies of the plans for transmission to the London office.
