The Donkey Boiler Survey of this vessel became due in July last.

Action has been deferred by the Classing Committee from time to time.

The vessel was surveyed in dry dock by the Society's Surveyor at Bristol last month, when he stated that she had now been transferred to the Russian Flag and was being towed to the Black Sea.

From a letter received from the late Owners it appears that she has now become the property of the U.S.S.R., whose practice it is invariably to allow the classification of their vessels to lapse as they become due for Special Survey.

It is observed from the Shipping Papers that the vessel is now on her way, in tow, to Batoum under the Russian Flag.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 23rd instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
