M. I duly received your letter of the 16th instant respecting the s.s. "ODINN", Kjobenhavns Flydedok og Skibsvaerft's Yard No.179, together with a plan shewing a proposal to increase the length of the ship by 13'-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and to acquaint you that the contents have been noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that on account of the additions made by the Owners to the scantlings and equipment at the time the vessel was built, they are found to be suitable for the increased length, and provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn on the plan, which is returned herewith, and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.
