A S.S. No. 3/ (vessel 33 years old) has been partly held. To complete the Special Survey the cross bunker and its 'tween deck space require to be examined and No. 2 double bottom tank in way tested.

The KOBE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom coated, and on account of grounding damage, as above, 37 shell plates repaired, 4 floors part renewed and 60 repaired and minor repairs effected.

The Special Survey ^{now} completed, as above, and wear and tear repairs effected to a shell plate, framing and deck plating in cross bunker.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 1.41 and notation of S.S. No. 3-12.39 ^{As recommended} without condition as recommended.
