No material alterations have taken place in the hull or superstructures which affect the position of the Load Lines. ✓

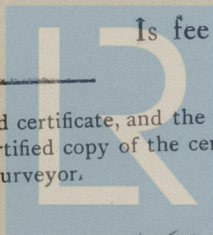
The nature of the closing appliances of bulkheads have been checked with the certificate. ✓
