this date.


I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with  
the given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be  
in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient  
condition.

Vessel surveyed afloat and on slipway in conjunction with  
S.S.No.1, now completed. S.S.Bsb.No.1-37 recommended.

Freeboard Certificate No.9532 endorsed (24th Nov.1937):-  
I have surveyed this ship for the purpose of seeing whether this  
certificate should remain in force, and the survey has been completed  
to my satisfaction."

Repairs now effected:- No.2 Hatch coaming, Port side and  
starboard end repaired by doublings. Nos.1 & 2 hatch coaming brackets re-  
newed as necessary. Forty wood hatch covers renewed. All side lights  
overhauled and two new G.M.frames and six new C.I.deadlights fitted.  
Overboard discharges overhauled and refitted.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree  
with the freeboards given on certificate No.9532 dated 4th June 1936.  
which is returned herewith will be returned.
