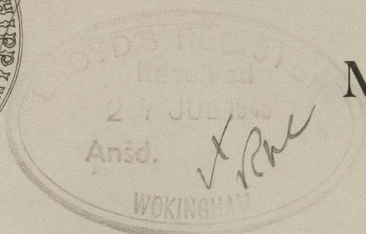

Dear Sir,

With reference to Middlesbrough Report No. 659 being forwarded to-day on the steamer "EMPIRE ANNAN", ex "MASUREN", we think it well to forward the under-noted particulars.

Superstructures.

The height of the poop as measured at poop front is 8'1", but heights from R.Q. deck to bridge deck and poop deck were equal and it is assumed that the upper deck is sunk in the poop.

Metal sockets 6" square and 3'11" apart are fitted on upper, R.Q. and bridge decks for uprights when carrying timber cargoes.

A copy of the freeboards as originally on the ship's side is attached.

The only plan available is the enclosed photostat of the capacity plan.

With regard to the fee chargeable for this survey we shall be glad to be informed of the amount to be charged in this case.
