In reply the Vancouver Surveyors state that the above mentioned Tug has recently been withdrawn from classification at the Owner's request, and that the Owner now considers that a Load Line is not necessary for their trade but have asked the Dominion Steamship Inspectors for a ruling on the matter and they will probably request us to drop the freeboard assignment.
