PROVISIONAL LOAD LINE CERTIFICATE.

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owner's Representative, Survey the Steel Screw Motorship "ISLAND COMMANDER", 271 tons gross of Vancouver, B. C., in accordance with Article 14 of the International Load Line Convention, 1930 for Periodical Survey, and the Survey has been completed to my satisfaction.

The freeboards assigned to the ship by the Committee of Lloyd's Register, marked on the ship's side and now verified by the undersigned are as follows:-

Tropical	1' - 9-1/2" (T)	3" above S.
Summer	2' - 0-1/2" (S)	Upper edge of line through centre of disc.
Winter	2' - 3-1/2" (W)	3" below S.
Winter North Atlantic	2' - 5-1/2" (W.N.A.)	5" below S.

Allowance for fresh water for all freeboards - 3 inches.

The upper edge of the deck line from which these freeboards are measured is at the level of the wood deck 3" above the top of the steel raised quarter deck at side.

This certificate is Provisional and is valid only until a new certificate is issued by the Committee of Lloyd's

This Certificate is issued upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of the Society, which provide that:
