
Further to our letter of the 14th June, 1943, having

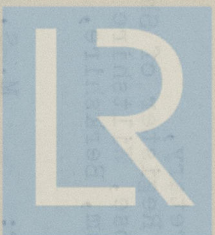
