"ISLAND COMMANDER"

We duly received your letter of the 12th ultimo together with all the enclosures referred to therein.

The contents of your communications were sent to the Island Tug & Barge Co., Owners of the above ship, and we enclose herewith a copy of a reply thereto, dated 6th instant, in which the Owners request that no action be taken either to fit a bulkhead at the after end of the forecandle or fit overboard scuppers 5" diameter in the upper deck immediately forward of the break of the quarter deck with storm valves at the ship's sides. This request is recommended for the favourable consideration of the Committee in view of the fact that the height of the break of the quarter deck is only 8" and " scuppers, one port and one starboard, are already fitted in the upper deck immediately forward of the break of the quarter deck with storm valves at the ship's sides.

Before doing anything further in this matter, we shall be pleased to have your instructions.
