ENCLOSURES.

Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 18th ultimo with its enclosures regarding the "ISLAND COMMANDER", ex "ANDREW KELLY", and I am now enclosing the usual assignment letters for transmission to the Vancouver Surveyors. As requested, a load line certificate and copy are enclosed for issue when the freeboards have been amended and verified, and the conditions of assignment complied with. An extra copy of the certificate is enclosed for transmission to the Canadian Authorities in due course.

I shall be glad if you will advise the Surveyors that the open sunk forecastle is considered to constitute an undesirable feature from the point of view of seaworthiness, and if the Owners do not wish to fit a bulkhead at the after end of this erection, overboard scuppers at least 5" in diameter, with stormvalves, should be fitted in the upper deck, immediately forward of the break of the quarterdeck to prevent water collecting in the sunk forecastle.
