This is to Certify that at the request of Messrs. The Kobe Steel Works, Ltd., Kobe, attend at their works on the 11th April 1933 and subsequent dates for the purpose of surveying during construction, two sets, two stage air compressors having cylinders, H.P. 310 m/m dia. and L.P. 340 m/m dia. by 180 m/m stroke.

The cylinders were tested by hydraulic pressure to 60 Kg/cm² internally and to 10 Kg/cm² and 2 Kg/cm² on the jacket side, and found sound and tight.

The H.P. coolers and connections were water tested to 60 Kg/cm² and jacket space to 5 Kg/cm² and found in order.

The L.P. coolers and connections were water tested to 7.5 Kg/cm² and jacket space to 5 Kg/cm² and found in order.

The compressors were finally assembled and tested under working condition on the 19th June 1933 connected to auxiliary diesel generators and found satisfactory.

After shop trial the machines were overhauled and examined, and found in good order.

These machines are intended for Harima Shipbuilding and Engineering Co. Ltd., Ship No. 109, and have been stamped as follows:-
