Sulzer Bros. attend at their Works to inspect and witness the tests carried out on the following castings and forgings, intended for a Two Stroke Cycle Double Acting Heavy Oil Engine, type 7D9D76, being constructed by Messrs. Kobe Steel Works.

The materials have been tested and found to be, as far as can be seen, sound and free from defects.

Hydraulic tests have been witnessed as detailed below, and the materials showed no signs of weakness, and were found tight and sound at the respective pressures.
