This is to Certify that the two Air Receivers made by Messrs. Osaka Iron Works, Ltd., Sakurajima Yard, Osaka, for Messrs. Harima Shipbuilding and Engineering Co., Yard No. 189 and marked as below, have been surveyed during construction by the undersigned. The material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register; the scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 30 Kg/cm², and the workmanship is good. The Air Receivers having been tested in my presence on the 25th and 27th March 1933 by hydraulic pressure to 44 Kg/cm², showed no signs of weakness, and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure not to exceed 30 Kg/cm².
