Mitsubishi Sosen Kaisha, Ltd., Kobe, attend at their works on the 17th March 1933 and subsequently for the purpose of examining and testing the 30 H.P. direct current motor driven rotary oil fuel transfer pump ordered by Kobe Seikosho and intended for Harima Shipbuilding and Engineering Co. Ship No. 189.

The pump casing was tested by hydraulic pressure to 6.8 kg/cm² and found to be sound and tight.

The pump was finally connected to a motor marked:-

and tried under working conditions on the 5th May 1933 and found to be satisfactory; capacity of pump 55.5 cubic metres/hour at 990 revs. per minute.


