This is to Certify that at the request of Messrs. The Kobe Steel Works, Ltd., Kobe, One 30 K.W. Diesel Engine generator set, having three cylinders, 165 m/m dia. x 245 m/m stroke, was examined and tested on the 8th October 1932 and subsequent dates.

The cylinders, in one casting, were tested by hydraulic pressure of 3.5 Kg/cm<sup>2</sup> on the jacket side and found sound and tight.

On completion, the engine was tested under full working conditions at 10% over load, and found satisfactory.

After running tests the engine was opened out and working parts examined and found in good order.

The Generator is intended for Marine Shipbuilding and Engineering Co. Ltd., yard No. 189, and has been stamped as follows:-
