Trawler "DOGGER BANK"

This vessel was built in 1913 and classed +100A1 "Steam Trawler". The class was withdrawn and (...) inserted in December, 1933.

The Grimsby Surveyors state they are informed by prospective buyers that they propose converting the trawler into a coasting vessel, and have the Society's class reinstated, and the Surveyors ask what fees should be charged for the reinstatement in class as a steamer.

If this vessel were a trawler the fee for 2nd S.S.No.3 on the hull would be £8, and as a coasting vessel the fee would be £15.

It is submitted that as regards the hull a fee of £15 might be charged for the reinstatement of class *and. jr*
