I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant respecting the motorship "A.A. COWAN", and note your remarks.

I may say that the Society has no Surveyor stationed on the West Coast of Africa, but arrangements can usually be made for surveys to be held at Ports where the Society's is not represented, by arranging for Lloyd's Agents to appoint a competent and independent technical man to carry out the Society's requirements. If therefore you will be so good as to indicate at what port the above vessel can be available for survey, the Committee will be happy to get into touch with the local agents for Lloyds and arrange for the case to receive attention.
