Dear Sirs,


I have to inform you that communications have been received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, respecting the steamers "BORDEAUX MARU", "CHINA MARU" and "OREGON MARU", from which I regret to note that you have decided not to maintain the classification of these vessels with this Society.
