H. Dear Sir

I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant respecting the tugs "ABEILLE NO.18", "ABEILLE NO.19" and "ABEILLE NO.22".

It is considered that the "ABEILLE NO.18" and "ABEILLE NO.19" should be submitted to the requirements of a Special Survey No.3 and that any part of the structure should be drill tested as deemed necessary by you.

With regard to the "ABEILLE NO.22", if it is decided to submit the vessel to reclassification, the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.3 should be carried out, and I shall be glad if you will advise me in due course of the Owners' decision in this case in order that particulars of the original shell thicknesses may be forwarded for your guidance in carrying out the Special Survey in question.
