Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo with reference to the draught of the steamer "BELVEDERE", and note your remarks.

It is observed that in this case the freeboards assigned by the Registro Italiano have been marked from the second deck, and you should advise this Office whether a tonnage opening has accordingly been fitted in the shelter deck and the vessel re-measured for tonnage. If such is the case particulars of any alterations which may have been made to the shelter tween deck bulkheads should be forwarded to this Office, together with particulars of the new tonnages, in order that the records in the Register Book may be amended.
