Mr Mares,

I have yours of 23rd re the preliminary freeboard for
34 ship & I have deferred replying until I have seen the builders.

I have explained to them what you say in your private letter,
while they would have accepted the draft had the scantlings of
ship not been reinforced but in view of the extra scantlings
they now desire the full freeboard permitted by the Tables.

I regret I am not in a position to answer whether the Austrian
Government have accepted the British regulations as regards passenger
ships, all that the Representative of the Government in the Commission
said is that the freeboards assigned under the Board of Trade
freeboard tables fulfil the requirements of the Ministerial Ordinance

Perhaps as this vessel does not come under the B of T regulation
I may be able to assign a freeboard which would meet the Owners
wishes, viz:- the same as the "LUCIA".
