These two ships have been classed with Bureau Veritas, and in view of the recent build and classification with this Society enquiries have been made from the PARIS Surveyor, who, on 7.5.48, enclosed a translation of a letter he received from the Owners confirming the classification with Bureau Veritas, and stating that "we cannot engage ourselves to pay any fee or indemnity whatever to another Classification Society" - see correspondence attached.

It is accordingly submitted for the consideration of the Committee whether the class of each of these ships be withdrawn from the Register Book, and 3 dots (...) be inserted in lieu, indicating that the class has been withdrawn at the Owners' request.
