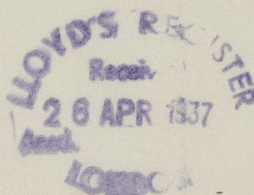

Under deck tonnage-----6,531.00 X

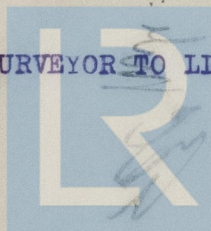
