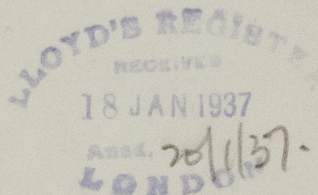

I am returning herewith for correction of registered dimensions, the above vessels classification certificate.

In this connection the builders state that part of the registered dimensions as given on the 1st Entry report were found to be incorrect and should have been 141.02 x 19.00 x 10.50 meters, instead of 141.50 x 19.00 x 10.50 meters.

Converted into feet the registered dimensions should be 462.67 x 62.34 x 34.45 feet.
