CERTIFICATE OF TANK TEST

This is to Certify that

Y. Hamada & Co. (Inn.).

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

Messrs. Osaka Nyosen Kaisha, Ltd., survey the No. 4 Deep Tank of the  
T.M.S. "HANKAI MARU",

3416 tons gross, of Osaka,  
whilst the vessel lay afloat at this port.

This Deep Tank was tested on the 16th June, 1941, by  
a head of water to the weather deck, and upon examination, the  
boundary bulkheads, tank top, hatches, ventilators and other  
connections were found sound and tight.

The Double Bottom Tank in way of this Deep Tank was  
tested on the 15th June, 1941, by a head of oil fuel to the  
weather deck and found sound and tight.

The heating coils in this Deep Tank were tested to  
twice the working pressure and found tight.

This Deep Tank is considered fit to receive a ship-  
ment of Cargo oil in bulk subject to examination for cleanli-  
ness before loading.
