

"YORICK"

This steam trawler was built in August 1909 and classed E100Al in the Society's Register Book.

In June 1939 the class was withdrawn at the Owners' request. She has now been taken over by the Ocean Steam Fishing Co., Hull and the Owners are desirous of having the vessel's class reinstated.

The Hull Surveyors point out that they understand that a complete Special Survey No.3 will be carried out including the drilling but doubt whether all the requirements to complete the Special Survey can be carried out at this time.

In order to have the vessel's class reinstated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the requirements of the 3rd S.S. No.3 which includes the drilling of the shell plating, to be carried out and full particulars of the equipment on board furnished.

In view of the possibility of the Special Survey not being completed, the vessel should be generally examined in dry dock in accordance with Circular 1772 with a view to notation of E100Al Steam Trawler, (Reclassification Contemplated) and "Examined (with date)" being assigned.

The Hull Surveyors should be referred to their Report No.44659 in which the particulars of the original and last drillings are indicated.

The reclassification fees should be in accordance with the requirements ~~==~~ given in the Rules for No.3 Survey.

It is submitted the Surveyors be advised accordingly.
