Vessel's Name "HOLMEN II".

B/S due 4.23,

Re s.s. "HOLMEN II" 160 Gross tons No. 62325 in the Reg. BK. The Owners of this vessel have intimated to me today, that, as she has now come under the Swedish Regulations, (which principally apply to passenger vessels), they have no need of and are not desirous of maintaining the vessel in the Society's class, which class should, consequently, be withdrawn and substituted with three dots (...) indicating that the class has been withdrawn at Owners' request.

The boiler survey became due in 4. 23, no part has been held.

The Owners do not wish to maintain the class.

It is submitted that the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book & three dots inserted in lieu thereof, indicating that the class has been withdrawn at the request of the Owners.
