Dear Sirs,

I return herewith the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 17th instant, of Boilers No. 1412 to be constructed by Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd., and have to acquaint you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 200 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to your entire satisfaction.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 30/34 tons per sq. inch.

I confirm my telegram to you to-day, as follows:-

"SWAN HUNTERS BOILERS 1412 PLAN APPROVED WORKING PRESSURE  
"200 POUNDS USUAL CONDITIONS"

It is noted that the boilers are intended for a vessel built in 1914 and at present lying at Fiume.
