
We herewith beg to enclose for the consideration of the Committee blue print of two Main Boilers which Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd. propose building for a working pressure of 200 lbs. per square inch.

The vessel for which these Boilers are intended is stated to be laying at Fiume. She was built in 1914 and has now been purchased by Messrs. Jadranska Plovidba D.D., of Susak. She is as yet unnamed. Two sets of Main Engines have been purchased on the Clyde (ex Government vessel). The Owners are supplying auxiliaries and Messrs. Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd. the Main Boilers.

As the matter is an urgent one concerning Contract time, the Boilermakers would be greatly obliged if approval could be given by wire.
