In confirmation of the conversation by telephone with your goodselves to-day, respecting the Engines No. 472 built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff Ltd. and proposed to be fitted on board Messrs. Ganz & Co. (Jadranska Plovidba) - Yard No. 68, I have to acquaint you that these engines were constructed under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors at Belfast from November, 1914, until May, 1915, and, provided the working parts of the engines be opened up and examined by the Society's Surveyors and found satisfactory and the engines be fitted on board the above vessel in accordance with the Society's Rules, a notation of ~~WNE~~ 5.15 (with present date) could be assigned.

I shall be glad if you will kindly advise me as soon as any definite decision is come to in regard to the engines and boiler for this vessel.
