Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "SALENTO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Naples, from which it appears that it is not your intention to maintain the vessel's class with this Society, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, instructions have been given for her class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
